

My Mom is Being Deployed





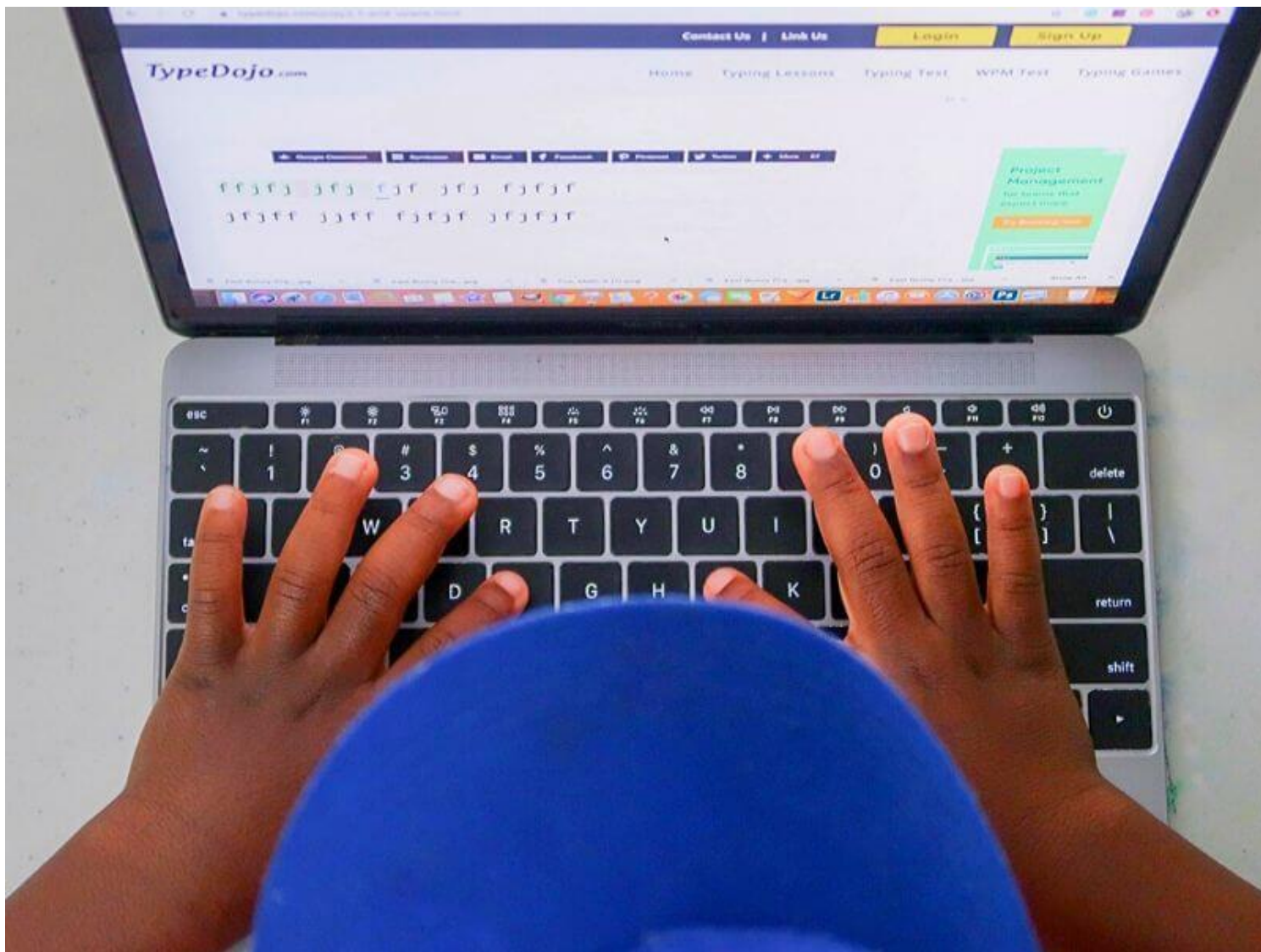
My mom goes to her job. My mom does not work in a store, in a factory, or in an office.
